Blue Thunder is the Home Team and is set up on the bench to your Right. After the Captain/Coach meeting, the R2 informs you that Red Coats has won the toss and elected to Serve.

Red Coats (RC) serve 2 points before Siding Out. Blue Thunder (BT) serves one point and sides out.

RC serves 2 more points and on the third rally commits a net violation on a block. Side out BT.

BT commits a service fault. RC scores 3 more points. BT requests a substitution, 11 for 3.

RC scores one more point and BT then requests a Time Out. BT wins the next rally and next 2 serves before siding out.

RC's Libero enters the match for #8 and scores 1 point before a service error. BT's big server is up and racks up 4 consecutive points! BT's setter commits a double fault on the next rally – side out RC. RC request a sub, 15 for 10. RC scores 2 more points and BT calls a time out.

BT is not ready to play at the conclusion of the T/O and the officials issue a **Yellow Unnecessary Delay (YUD)**. RC serves long and out. BT subs #3 back into the match for #11. BT serves 3 straight points. In frustration, RC coach calls a Time Out. RC gets a successful kill on the next rally.

RC serves 3 straight points. The BT coach stands up yelling "WTF" at his team and slams his clipboard to the floor. R1 issues a **Red Card** for extreme unsporting conduct. BT manages to side out on the next rally. Libero enters to serve for BT and scores 2 points before serving into the net.

The Libero for RC leaves the court on the side out and is replaced by #8. RC serves 2 more points and loses the next rally on a net violation.

BT serves 2 more points. RC subs #10 back in for #15 and get the side out on next rally.

BT subs #11 back in for #3. BT wins the next rally. #11 commits a "Foot Fault" on serve causing a loss of rally and giving RC the set point.

Now record your final scores, Set time (5:40), and ask R2 to sign/review scoresheet.
